
GEN 1.4 Entry, Transit and Departure of Cargo

1. Customs Requirements Concerning Cargo and Other Articles

1.1 Operators of aircraft engaged in commercial air traffic must submit to the customs authorities a general declaration and a summary cargo manifest.

1.1.1 If no passengers or cargo are carried, a NIL manifest must be presented.

1.2 The customs handling of cargo is normally based on the information in the customs declaration and the cargo manifest. Special customs handling of cargo (including arriving/departing aircraft which have been bought in or sold to non EU member states) as import, transit or export must follow the EU customs regulations. The local customs authorities may give further information on the subject.

2. Agricultural Quarantine Requirements

2.1 Live animals and non-food products of animal origin

2.1.1 Sanitary certificates or related documents are required when importing live animals, semen, embryos and aquaculture animals and products into Denmark, except when importing finches, including canaries, as pets, or when importing less than 4 guinea pigs, hamsters, mice, rats, turtles and iguanas accompanied by persons.

2.1.2 Sanitary certificates or related documents are also required when importing non-food products of animal origin, except for game trophies from other EU member states or processed animal products (semi-manufactured).

2.2 Food of animal origin

Sanitary certificates or related documents are required when importing foods of animal origin, including fish and fishery products, into Denmark, except when importing

- food of animal origin, including fish and fishery products, originating in another EU member state or in Norway, the Faeroe Islands or Greenland, and which are accompanied by persons for non-commercial use in the household of the importing person, and
- health marked milk products, other products with a content of milk, dessert in which part of the milk content has been substituted by vegetable oil, preserved milk in which part of the milk content has been substituted by vegetable oil, hen's eggs and honey from other EU member states.
