**AD 1.4 Grouping of Aerodromes/Heliports**

---

**1. General**

The criteria applied by the Danish Transport Authority in the grouping of aerodromes/heliports in Denmark for the provision of information in Aeronautical Information Publications are as detailed in the following.

*Note: In Denmark, separate heliports are presently not available for public air transport.*

**2. Major International Airports**

Airports approved for international commercial and non-commercial public air transport operations in accordance with the Instrument Flight Rules and for which Instrument Approach Procedures are established. Details of these airports are given in the AIP.

For VFR use, selected information are also published in the VFR Flight Guide (VFG)

**3. Other International Airports**

Airports approved only for international commercial and non-commercial public air transport operations in accordance with the Visual Flight Rules.

Selected information about these airports are given in the VFG.

**4. National Aerodromes**

Aerodromes approved only for domestic air transport operations in accordance with the Visual Flight Rules.

Selected information about these aerodromes are given in the VFG.

**5. Private Airfields**

Privately established airfields on which the use is subject to the owners permission.

Selected basic information about these airfields are given in the VFG.
